SUPPLEMENT

To an act to authorize the Governor to incorporate the Cherry Ridge and East Sterling Turnpike Road company, and for other purposes, passed the seventh day of May, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That William R. McLawry, Richard Lancaster, Lucius Collins, Reuben R. Purdy and William Bortree, of Wayne county, commissioners appointed by the act to which this is a supplement, be authorized to re-open books for the subscription of stock to the Cherry Ridge and East Sterling turnpike road company, at such times and places as said commissioners may direct, giving notice as prescribed in the original act, to which this is a supplement. Commence-

SECTION 2. That if said company shall not commence said turnpike road within two years from the passage of this act, and complete the same within six years, then, in either case, the charter shall revert to this commonwealth. ment & completion

SECTION 3. The said road shall terminate at or near Salem Corners, in the county of Wayne, and when seven miles thereof or more is completed, the said company shall have the authority to take and receive tolls thereon, for the distance so completed. Termination Tolls
