A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled " An Act to incorporate the Philadelphia Typographical society," passed May seventh, eighteen hundred and thirty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, as provides that the members of said society, in case of sickness or accident, shall receive the sum of five dollars per week, be, and the same is hereby repealed; and hereafter the members of the said society, in case of sickness or accident, shall receive such sum as may be allowed in the by-laws.
