AN ACT

Authorizing the Commissioners of Kensington district to make such alterations in the plans heretofore made in the survey and regulations of streets and water courses, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the board of commissioners of the Kensington district of the Northern Liberties, shall have full power and authority, and they are hereby authorized to make such alterations in the lines of the streets and water courses of said district as they may deem necessary for the better regulation of the same: Provided, Such alterations can be made without prejudice or injury to property already improved, in conformity with the existing plans of said district: And provided further, That the alterations shall be made within three years after the passage of this act, and be approved of by the court of quarter sessions of the county of Philadelphia.*
