A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled " An Act relating to the claims of Samuel S. Barton and others, and for other purposes," passed the eighth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

Construction
of former act

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of the sixth section of the act, to which this is a supplement, as imposes a tax upon the citizens of the borough of Stroudsburg, in the county of Monroe, for the purpose of purchasing a fire engine for the use of said borough, shall be so construed as to extend to improved property, within the said borough, owned by non-residents, and also to the court house, county offices and prison, situate in the said borough.
