AN ACT

For the relief of Charles Fisher and Christian Fisher.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and required, to view and assess the damages sustained by Charles Fisher and Christian Fisher, by the construction of the Pennsylvania canal through their land, situated on the Isle of Que, in the county of Union; and if any thing should be found due them, or either of them, they or he shall be entitled to a credit for the amount on the books of the auditor general, bearing interest at the rate of six per centum from the date of the entry.
