A SUPPLEMENT

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the original act to which this is a supplement, is hereby revived and re-enacted, and that the said company shall commence the said work within three years, and shall complete the same within six years from the passage of this supplement, according to the true intent and meaning of the act to which this is a supplement.
