AN ACT

To authorize the Commissioners of Philadelphia county to borrow money.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the county board of Philadelphia county is hereby authorized to direct the commissioners of said county to borrow, on the credit of the county, a sum not exceeding sixty thousand dollars, for a period not exceeding twelve months, in anticipation of the revenue of one thousand eight hundred and forty-three.
