A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Mount Carbon and Port Carbon Railroad company, and for other purposes," passed the sixteenth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners appointed by the act to which this is a supplement, may open books for subscription to the stock of the company to be incorporated under said act, at any time before the first day of December next; and the time given for the commencement of the said railroad shall be and the same is hereby extended to one year from the passage of this act, and the time for completing the same is hereby extended to three years from the passage of this act.

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SECTION 2. That the commissioners of M'Kean county are hereby authorized to expend a sum of money, to be drawn from the funds of said county, not exceeding the sum of two thousand dollars, in making a certain road, beginning at Fort Allegheny, on the Allegheny river, thence down said river and on the east side of the same till it intersects the Milesburg and Smethport turnpike, a distance of about nine miles.
