AN ACT

To incorporate the White Hall Mutual Fire Insurance Association of parts of Bucks and Montgomery counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jonathan Evans, William Harrar, Samuel Corporators Walter, Henry Landis, John Shipe, Isaiah James, Michael Snyder, David Evans, Hervey Mathias and David R. Johnson, and such other persons as are or may be associated with them under the authority of the same, are hereby made a corporation by the name of the White Hall Mutual Fire Name Insurance Association of parts of Bucks and Montgomery counties, and they or their successors, citizens of New Britain, Warrington, Doylestown, Hillstown, Warwick, Montgomery and Hatfield townships, in said counties, are hereby made a body politic and corporate in law, with all the rights Powers and privileges of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed tenth day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-three. The persons named in this act shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer.
