A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Clifford and Carbondale turnpike road company, and for laying out a state road from the Virginia state line, in the county of Fayette, to Centreville, in the county of Somerset, and for other purposes."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and managers of the Clifford and Carbondale turnpike road company are hereby authorized and empowered to extend their road from its termination on the Carbondale township line, in the county of Luzerne, into the village of Carbondale, in the said county, agreeably in every respect with the provisions of their act of incorporation.

SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this act no person shall be eligible to the office of treasurer of the Cocheston and Great Bend turnpike road company, who is not at the time of his election a resident citizen of this commonwealth.
