A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act relating to inspectors, passed the fifteenth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the first day of June next, flour of wheat which shall be offered for sale in the borough of York, in the county of York, shall be liable to be inspected in the manner prescribed, and under the penalties provided in the act to which this is a supplement, whether the purchaser shall request such inspection or not. SECTION 2. *That the provisions of the fifth section of an act, entitled "An Act to confer on George, Polly, Susan, Elizabeth and Peggy Strohl, and Marinda Wurtz, the rights and benefits of children born in lawful wedlock, and for other purposes,"* passed the eleventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby extended to the borough of Allentown, Lehigh county. SECTION 3. That from and after the tenth day of May, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, the several acts of assembly of this commonwealth that relate to the imposing a tax on dogs in the county of Chester, be repealed, so far as regards the township of East Bradford, West Nantmeal, Thornbury, Honeybrook, Birmingham, West Pikeland, West Town, East and West Goshen, London, Brittain, and the borough of West Chester, in said county. SECTION 4. And the provisions of the fifteenth, sixteenth and seventeenth sections of the "Act to incorporate the Luzerne County Mutual Insurance company, and for other purposes," approved the twenty-seventh day of May, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty, be extended to the aforesaid townships and borough, except that the first day of February, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, appearing in the said fifteenth section, be made the first day of February, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, so far as it regards this enactment; and that the first Monday in March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, appearing in the said sixteenth Chester co

section, be made the first Monday in March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, so far as it regards this enactment.

AN ACT

Relative to supervisors in the township of Augusta, in the county of Northumberland, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall hereafter be lawful for the qualified voters of Augusta township, in the county of Northumberland, annually, to elect three supervisors of roads for said township at the time and place now fixed by law for the election of supervisors; and the election of three supervisors which took place in said township on the seventeenth day of March, instant, is hereby declared good and valid, to all intents and purposes, as if the same had been held and conducted in pursuance of law.

SECTION 2. That the act supplementary to an act granting certain powers to the authorities of the cities of Lancaster and Philadelphia, and for other purposes, passed the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, and extended to the county of Chester, the twenty-seventh day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, relating to letting out the public roads by contract by the supervisors of the several townships in the county of Chester, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as relates to the townships of Honeybrook, Newlin, East Marlborough and West Bradford, in said county.
