AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of Mary Ann Crilly and Michael Crilly.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Michael Crilly and Mary Ann Crilly, his wife, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, and from all legal duties, as if they had never been joined in marriage.*
