AN ACT

To attach part of the eighth to the ninth division of the Pennsylvania Militia, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Warren infantry and Warren and Little Meadows rifle company, two independent military companies of Bradford and Susquehanna counties, are hereby attached to and shall form a part of the ninth division of the Pennsylvania militia; and all former proceedings and elections had and held by said companies under existing laws of this commonwealth, are hereby legalized in all respects, the same as if all the members of said companies had originally resided within the bounds of the said ninth division of Pennsylvania militia.

SECTION 2. That the adjutant general of this commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized and required to furnish, upon the requisition of the proper brigade inspector, out of any arms remaining in any of the state arsenals, the usual number of arms and equipments necessary for arming and equipping "The Warren and Little Meadows rifle company" of Susquehanna and Bradford counties.
