Section 15. All orders and regulations of the Department of Health shall be promulgated by sending printed copies to all local boards of health, clerks of councils of cities and boroughs, and *county superintendents of public schools*, and by printing once in at least one daily paper of *the city of Philadelphia* and *one of Pittsburgh*, and the orders and regulations shall be printed in circular form and given to any one who demands them.

AN ACT

To repeal an act, approved the fourth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred twenty-two), entitled "An act authorizing a written demand for a jury trial in actions at law in the several courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth, by either party thereto; regulating the procedure of trials at law by a judge without a jury, and authorizing the several courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth to adopt rules for regulating the procedure under this act; and regulating appeals from judgments."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the act, approved the fourth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred twenty-two), entitled "An act authorizing a written demand for a jury trial in actions at law in the several courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth, by either party thereto; regulating the procedure of trials at law by a judge without a jury, and authorizing the several courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth to adopt rules for regulating the procedure under this act; and regulating appeals from judgments," be, and the same is hereby, repealed.
