(\$25,00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than ten days.

To further amend section nine of the act, approved the sixteenth day of May, one thousand nine bundred and twenty-nine (Pamphlet Laws, seventeen hundred eighty), entitled "An act to fix the salaries and compensation of the judges of Supreme Court, the judges of the Superior Court, the judges of the courts of common pleas, the judges of the orphans' courts, the judges of the Municipal Court of Philadelphia, and the judges of the County Court of Allegheny County," by reducing the compensation and further defining the traveling expenses of judges sation and further defining the traveling expenses of judges presiding in other districts.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section nine of the Judges' salaries. act, approved the sixteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine (Pamphlet Laws, seventeen hundred eighty), entitled "An act to fix the salsection 9, act of aries and compensation of the judges of Supreme Court, May 16, 1929 (P. L. 1780), as the judges of the Superior Court, the judges of the orphans of May 6, 1931 (P. L. 97), further amended. aries and compensation of the judges of Supreme Court, the judges of the Superior Court, the judges of the courts of common pleas, the judges of the orphans' courts, the judges of the Municipal Court of Philadelphia, and the judges of the County Court of Allegheny County," as amended by the act approved the sixth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, ninety-seven), is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 9. When any judge learned in the law is Assigned judges. called in, as now provided by law, to assist the judge or judges of any other judicial district, such judge so called in shall be entitled to receive, for each day he is actually engaged in the performance of such duty, the sum of [thirty dollars (\$30)] twenty dollars (\$20) per compensation and traveling expenses, not in excess of ten expenses. cents for each mile travelled, to and from the place of holding court in such district.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first Effective date. day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-
