## AN ACT

To establish as a State highway a certain section of public road in the county of Lackawanna, and providing for its construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That a certain section of public road, commencing at a point on Main Street in the borough of Archbald, Lackawanna County, at an intersection of Main Street and Wayne Street, thence eastwardly along said Wayne Street, thence in a northeasterly direction to a point on the road known as Salem Street, in said borough, east of the point where said road is crossed by the siding of the Archbald Coal Company, thence along said Salem Street or Salem Road to the village of Cortez, Jefferson Township, said county, shall be adopted by the Commonwealth as a State highway, and shall be constructed, improved and maintained at the sole expense of the Commonwealth under existing laws.

Section 2. The cost and expense of the construction, improvement and maintenance of the highway herein described shall be paid out of any moneys appropriated to the Department of Highways for the construction, improvement, reconstruction or maintenance of State highways.

## AN ACT

Establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth.

Streets described.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the following streets in boroughs or incorporated towns shall, respectively, be adopted as State highways, to be constructed and maintained at the expense of the Commonwealth under the provisions of present or future laws governing State highways in boroughs.

Section 2. The streets taken over under the authority of this act are situate and described, as follows:
