## AN ACT

To amend the act, approved the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred ninety-four), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," by changing certain routes and adding certain new routes.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the following routes established by the act, approved the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred ninety-four), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," are hereby amended to read as follows:

Route 01047. Beginning at a point in [Huntingdon] Huntington Township on the Adams-Cumberland County line about .5 of a mile east of the Tyrone-[Huntingdon] Huntington Township line; thence southwestwardly through [Huntingdon] Huntington Township to a point [intersecting] on Route 01006; thence eastwardly through [Huntingdon] Huntington Township, by way of Idaville and Gargol, [to a point, intersecting Route 342 at the York Springs Borough line] intersecting Route 41 at Idaville, to a point on the western boundary line of York Springs Borough, in Adams County, a distance of about 6.4 miles.

Route 02002. Beginning at a point on Route 742 in Penn Township [at] near the Penn-Wilkins Township line, and extending easterly, thence northerly to a point on the Frankstown Road, Route [288] 228, about 0.3 of a mile west of Rodi, in Allegheny County, a distance of about [1.5] 1.43 miles.

Route 02017. Beginning at a point in Penn Township on the Saltsburg Road, Route 228, and extending in a southerly and southeasterly direction, by way of the Stolter Road, to an intersection with [Frankstown Road] county Universal Road near the property of Jacob Berg, in Allegheny County, a distance of about [1.7] 1.69 miles.

line; thence in an easterly direction to an intersection with the Clifton-Bridgeville Road; thence in a [northerly] northeasterly direction to a point [near] on the county road at the village of Beadling; thence beginning on the county road near the Mount Lebanon-Upper Saint Clair Township line, and running in a northwesterly direction to an intersection with the Bower Hill Road [about .25 of a mile from the Mount Lebanon Township line], in Allegheny County, a distance of about [4.2] 3.91 miles.

Beginning at a point in Penn Township [intersecting Route 190 about 1.5 miles north of Hanover] on the castern boundary line of Hanover Borough; thence easterly through Penn and Heidelberg Townships to a point intersecting Route 230 at Jacob's Mills; thence from a point intersecting Route 230 about .5 of a mile west of Jacob's Mills, southerly through

Heidelberg and Mainheim Townships to a point, intersecting Route 441 about .5 of a mile east of Mainheim-Penn Township line; thence from a point intersecting Route 441 about one mile northwest of Marburg; thence northeasterly through Manheim, Heidelberg, and North Codorus Townships, by way of Porters, to a point intersecting Route 644 at Stoverstown; thence from a point intersecting Route 644 about .25 of a mile north of Stoverstown, northwesterly through North Codorus, West Manchester, and Jackson Townships, by way of Bair's Station, to a point intersecting Route 230 about .5 of a mile [south west] southwest of Bair; thence from a point in Jackson Township on Route 230 about .75 of a mile southwest of Bair to intersect Route 126 [at] near Thomasville; thence northerly through Jackson and Dover Townships, intersecting State-aid Application 6518 near Davidsburg, to a point intersecting Route 66034 at Harmony Grove, in York County, a distance of about [27.51] 26.11 miles.

Route 66050. Beginning at a point in North Codorus Route 66050. Township [intersecting Route 492 about .25 of a mile north of] on the eastern boundary line of New Salem Borough; thence northeasterly through North Codorus and West Manchester Townships to a point [intersecting] of intersection of Hoke Avenue [about .25 of a mile south of and the southern boundary line of West York Borough; thence from a point in Spring Garden Township, intersecting State-aid Application 4952 at the Northern Central Railroad underpass, westerly, southerly, and southeasterly, through Spring Garden and York Townships, intersecting Route 127, to a point on Route 216 about .5 of a mile south of Spry; thence from a point, again intersecting Route 216 about one mile south of Spry, southerly through York and Springfield Townships to a point intersecting Route 66010 about 1.5 miles southwest of Rye, in York County, a distance of about [13.12] 12.87 miles.

Route 66059. Beginning at a point in Lower Chance- Route 66059. ford Township intersecting Route 216 about one mile southeast of Lower Chanceford-Chanceford Township line; thence northeasterly, via Goram, [to a point intersecting Route 332 at Shenks Ferry, in York County, a distance of about 4.03 miles] past Kohler's Mill to an intersection with Route 332, near Bethel Church, in York County.

Route 66105. Beginning at a point [on the Railroad Route 66105. Borough line near the northwest corner of said borough in Shrewsbury Township] on the Shrewsbury Borough-Shrewsbury Township line, leading in a southwesterly direction to the Railroad Borough-Shrewsbury Township line; beginning again at a point on the Railroad Borough line near the northwest corner of said borough in Shrewsbury Township, and leading in a northwesterly direction, along the tracks of the Baltimore Division

of the Pennsylvania Railroad, toward Glen Rock Borough and intersecting Route 66004 at a point about .75 of a mile south of Seitzland, in York County, a distance of about 1.7 miles.

Route 66107.

Route 66107. Beginning at a point on Route 332 in Chanceford Township [half way between St. Johns and Bethel Churches, into the village of Lockport, in York County, a distance of about 1.8 miles.] at a point about 4 of a mile east of Bethel Church, on Route 332 to Shenks Ferry, York County, a distance of about 1.2 miles.

Routes added.

Section 2. That said act is hereby amended by add-

ing thereto the following routes:

Route 02201.

Route 02201. Beginning at or near the intersection of State Highway Route 397 and Rural Route 02034 in Allegheny County; thence in a southerly direction, over a dedicated right of way or right of way purchased by the county commissioners, to the Bridgeville Borough-South Fayette Township line at the continuation of Villars Avenue, in Allegheny County, a distance of about .5 of a mile.

Route 05091.

Route 05091. Beginning at a point on Route 692 approximately .375 of a mile north of Sexton Borough line in Liberty Township, Bedford County; thence northeasterly through Liberty Township to a point on the Bedford-Huntingdon County line, approximately .25 of a mile south of the Raystown Branch of the Juniata River, at an intersection with Route 31019, in Bedford County, a distance of about .3 of a mile.

Route 08119.

Route 08119. Beginning at a point on Route 08066, in Athens Township, about three hundred feet south of its intersection with Route 08114, being the point of intersection of said Route 08066 with McDuffee Street; thence easterly on McDuffee Street to Pennsylvania Avenue; thence southerly on Pennsylvania Avenue to the west end of Lincoln Street; thence easterly on Lincoln Street to the west line of Sayre Borough, in Bradford County, a distance of about one mile.

Route 08120.

Route 08120. Beginning at the point where Cayuta Street ends at the northeasterly boundary line of Sayre Borough and Athens Townships; thence northeasterly through Athens and Litchfield Townships, along the River-State line road, to the New York State line, in Bradford County, a distance of about 1.9 miles.

Route 18025.

Route 18025. Beginning at a point where Route 17068 intersects the Clearfield-Clinton County line; thence northeasterly in West Keating Township to Birch Island Run, in Clinton County, a distance of about 3.5 miles.

Route 21061.

Route 21061. Beginning at a point on the boundary line of Cumberland and Franklin Counties, intersecting Rural Route 28009; thence southeasterly through Shippensburg Township to a point on the boundary line of Shippensburg Borough, in Cumberland County, a distance of about .31 of a mile.

Koute 23095. Beginning at a point on Flower Street Route 23095. in Chester Township at the intersection of Concord Avenue, Route 180, and running thence to a point at the line of the city of Chester, 243.34 feet north of Ninth Street, in Delaware County, a total distance of 1440 feet.

Route 25080. Beginning at the end of Route 304. Route 25080. Spur, on the Northeast-Greenfield Township line, in Erie County; thence southeasterly through Greenfield Township to a point on the New York State line, in Erie Coun-

ty, a distance of about .35 of a mile.

Route 26110. Beginning at a point on the Fayette- Route 26110. Westmoreland County line at the eastern terminus of Route 64074, and extending in a southerly, southeasterly, and northeasterly direction through Elk Lick Township, by way of Trout Run Church, to intersect Route 55049 on the Fayette-Somerset County line near its intersection with the Fayette-Westmoreland County line, in Fayette County, a distance of about 1.3 miles.

Route 31079. Beginning at a point about .5 of a mile Route 31079. northwest of Grantsville in Penn Township, and extending in a northwestwardly direction to the east borough line of Marklesburg Borough, a distance of about .23 of

a mile, in Huntingdon County.

Route 32117. Beginning at a point on Route 32021 Route 32117. approximately one-eighth mile south of the village of Rexis, in Buffington Township, Indiana County; thence easterly through Buffington Township to Main Street, Vintondale Borough, on the Indiana-Cambria County line, in Indiana County, a distance of about 0.2 of a mile.

Route 35046. Beginning at a point of intersection with Route 35046. Child's Road and the Carbondale Township-Mayfield Borough line; thence northerly, by way of Child's Road, through Carbondale Township to a point on the Carbondale City line, in the county of Lackawanna, a distance

of about two miles.

Route 53072. Beginning at a point on State Highway Route 53072. Route 199 at Branchdale in Reilly Township; thence northerly and easterly through Reilly and Cass Townships to point of intersection with Route 53071 at Forestville, in Schuylkill County, a distance of about 2.8 miles.

Route 53073. Beginning at a point of road intersec- Route 53073. tion about .25 of a mile north of the point of intersection of Cass, New Castle and Norwegian Township lines, in Cass Township; thence northeasterly through Cass and New Castle Townships to a point where it intersects Route 53032 at Wade, in Schuylkill County, a distance of about 1.6 miles.

Route 53074. Beginning at a point on State Highway Route 53074. Route 141, in North Manheim Township, approximately .7 of a mile west of the western Orwigsburg boundary line; thence southerly through North Manheim Township, by way of Adamsdale, to the northern boundary line of Landingville Borough, in Schuylkill County, a distance of about 1.3 miles.

Route 53075.

Route 53075. Beginning at a point on the west borough line of Landingville; thence southerly and southwesterly through South Mainheim Township to Route 53007 at Brommerstown, in Schuylkill County, a distance of about 2.9 miles:

Route 55109.

Route 55109. Beginning at a point on the Windber Borough-Paint Township line, in Somerset County, about one-eighth mile north of Paint Creek; thence paralleling Paint Creek in an easterly direction to the Somerset-Cambria County line, about 2.00 miles in length.

Route 55110.

Route 55110. Beginning at a point on Route 456 near the Central City Borough line; thence in a northerly direction to an intersection with Application 6448 in Shade Township, Somerset County, a distance of about 1 mile.

Route 55111.

Route 55111. Beginning at a point on Route 55043 about one-eighth of a mile south of the borough line of Somerset; thence in a northerly direction to the east borough line of Somerset, in Somerest County, a distance of about 0.6 of a mile.

Route 55112.

Route 55112. Beginning at a point on Route 52 about 2.10 miles northeast of the Somerset Borough-Somerset Township line near the village of Geiger; thence northeasterly through Somerset Township, in Somerset County, a distance of about 1.36 miles.

Route 55113.

Route 55113. Beginning at a point at the end of the bridge spanning the Youghiogheny River about 200 feet south of Confluence Borough; thence easterly and northerly to the Confluence Borough line at Yough Road, in Somerset County, a distance of about 0.04 of a mile.

Route 58077.

Somerset County, a distance of about 0.04 of a mile.
Route ≤8077. Beginning at a point on Route 58042
about 0.70 of a mile east of the village of Charleston, in
Charleston Township; thence in a northeasterly direction to a point known as Benedict's Corner, in Tioga
County, a distance of about 3.14 miles.

Route 58078.

Route 58078. Beginning at a point on the Bradford-Tioga County line approximately 0.25 of a mile north of the Union Township line; thence over the lower mountain road in a westerly direction to its intersection with Route 58057 in Ward Township, Tioga County, a distance of approximately 2.75 miles.

Construction and maintenance.

Section 3. The highways established as State highways under the provisions of this act may be taken over for construction and maintenance at any time subsequent to the approval of this act, but shall be taken over not later than the fifteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.

When routes shall be taken over.
