

Section 2. Section six of the act, approved the second day of April, A. AN ACT

Prescribing the fees to be received by registers of wills in counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following fees shall be received by registers of wills in counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class:

Counties of 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th class.

Fees of registers of wills in such counties.

Accounts: Filing, recording accounts of executors, administrators and guardians, including transmission of same to orphans' court and confirmation:
