AN ACT

Amending the act of August twenty-one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1309), entitled "An act prescribing the fees to be received by registers of wills in counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class," eliminating counties of the fourth class.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Counties of 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th class.

Section 1. The title and the first paragraph of section one, act of August twenty-one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1309), entitled "An act prescribing the fees to be received by registers of wills in counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class," are amended to read:

Title and 1st paragraph, section 1, act of August 21, 1953, P. L. 1309, amended.

Prescribing the fees to be received by registers of wills in counties of the [fourth] fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class.

Title.

Section 1. The following fees shall be received by registers of wills in counties of the [fourth] fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class:

Fees of registers of wills in such counties.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-six.

Amending the act of August twenty-one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1306), entitled "An act prescribing the fees to be received by the clerks of orphans' courts of counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class," eliminating counties of the fourth class.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Counties of 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th class.

Section 1. The title and the first paragraph of section one, act of August twenty-one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1306), entitled "An act prescribing the fees to be received by the clerks of orphans' courts of counties of the fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class," are amended to read:

Title and 1st paragraph, section 1, act of August 21, 1953, P. L. 1306, amended.

AN ACT

Title. Prescribing the fees to be received by the clerks of orphans' courts of counties of the [fourth] fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class.

Fees of clerks of orphans' courts in such counties. Section 1. The following fees shall be received by the clerks of orphans' courts in counties of the [fourth] fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class:

Effective date. Section 2. This act shall take effect July one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-six.

AN ACT

Amending the act of August ten, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1163), entitled as amended "An act relating to the orphans' court; conferring exclusive jurisdiction on such courts over the administration and distribution of decedents' estates, trust estates, minors' estates, and absentees' estates; conferring concurrent jurisdiction over the administration and distribution of incompetents' estates and the determination of title to real estate in certain cases; providing for the organization of orphans' courts, the procedure therein, the powers and duties of the judges thereof, and appeals therefrom," providing for the fixing of costs where there are separate orphans' courts.

Orphans' Court Act of 1951.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 503, act of August 10, 1951, P. L. 1163, amended.

Section 1. Section five hundred three, act of August ten, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1163), known as the "Orphans' Court Act of 1951," is amended to read:

Section 503. Bill of Costs.—(a) Each orphans' court may establish a bill of costs to be charged for the services of the clerk not otherwise provided for by law.

(b) *Each separate orphans' court may establish a bill of costs to be charged to the parties and the estates before them for settlement for the services of the clerk in the transaction of the business of such court.*

Effective date.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July one, one thousand nine hundred fifty-six.
