

## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1937 (P. L. 487), entitled, as amended, "An act to provide for the permanent personal registration of electors in cities of the second class, cities of the second class A, cities of the third class, boroughs, towns, and townships as a condition of their right to vote at elections and primaries, and their enrollment as members of political parties as a further condition of their right to vote at primaries; prescribing certain procedure for the conduct of elections and primaries and the challenge and proof of qualifications of electors; requiring the county commissioners of the various counties to act as a registration commission therefor; and prescribing the powers and duties of citizens, parties, political bodies, registration commissions, commissioners, registrars, inspectors of registration and other appointees of registration commissions, county election boards, election officers, municipal officers, departments and bureaus, police officers, courts, judges, prothonotaries, sheriffs, county commissioners, peace officers, county treasurers, county controllers, registrars of vital statistics, certain public utility corporations, real estate brokers, rental agents, and boards of school directors; and imposing penalties," requiring the commission to prepare for each election district a list of the names and addresses of registered electors arranged by streets and house numbers or alphabetically.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Subsection (a),

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 33, act of April 29, 1937 (P. L. 487), known as "The Permanent Registration Act for Cities of the Second Class, Cities of the Second Class A, Cities of the Third Class, Boroughs, Towns and Townships," reenacted and amended May 31, 1955 (P. L. 62), is amended to read:

Section 33. Street Lists; Posting.—(a) Commencing not later than the \*fiftieth day prior to each primary and election, the commission shall prepare for each election district a [street] list of the names and addresses of all registered electors as of that date resident in the district, arranged by streets and house numbers, or *arranged alphabetically: Provided, That the method of arranging such lists alphabetically as authorized by this amendment shall not be used by any commission which heretofore prepared such lists by streets and house numbers and the method of arranging such lists alphabetically shall be discontinued not later than three years after the effective date of this amendment.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
