(b) This section shall not apply to any county in which there has been created by existing law a similar board of control, and any references to the board of control in this subdivision shall be inapplicable in so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of such law.

AN ACT

Amending the act of May 19, 1887 (P. L. 138), entitled "An act providing for payment of costs in criminal cases by the proper county," providing for payments to constables.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3, act of May 19, 1887 (P. L. 138), entitled "An act providing for payment of costs in criminal cases by the proper county," amended August 26, 1953 (P. L. 1451), is amended to read:

Section 3. All costs payable by a county to any alderman [or], justice of the peace *or constable* pursuant to the provisions of this act shall be due and payable to such alderman, [or] justice of the peace *or constable* within thirty days of the end of the calendar month in which transcripts were filed: Provided, That such payment shall in no way alter any rights of such county to reimbursement for such costs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
