AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1945 (P. L. 1242), entitled "An act relating to roads, streets, highways and bridges; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws administered by the Secretary of Highways and by the Department of Highways relating thereto," authorizing the Department of Highways to construct and maintain cattle passes under State highways and rural State highways hereafter constructed or relocated.

State Highway Law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Act of June 1, 1945, P. L. 1242, amended by adding a new section 401.1.

Section 1. The act of June 1, 1945 (P. L. 1242), known as the "State Highway Law," is amended by adding, after section 401, a new section to read:

Section 401.1. Cattle Crossings.—Whenever it appears to be necessary and suitable in the interest of public safety as a traffic precaution, or to keep substantial portions of a farm readily accessible to cattle and other livestock, the department is authorized to construct and maintain cattle crossings or passes under State highways or rural State highways hereafter constructed or relocated.

Act effective immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Providing for the rendition of certain reports by public bodies, corporate and politic, known as "Authorities."

Authorities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Authorities to submit a certain report to the municipality.

Section 1. It is the duty of every public body, corporate and politic, constituting an "Authority," and created for any purpose in accordance with the laws of this Commonwealth, to submit to the municipality or municipalities which incorporated it, or for which it was incorporated, a report at the end of every six month period, containing the names of all employes of the "Authority," their position and salary. This report shall be open to public inspection upon demand.

Report open to public.

Effective date.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately, and the first report required shall be submitted not later than January 10, 1958.
