SB 1117

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," deleting a route in Dauphin County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," and its amendments, is deleted as follows:

Dauphin County

[Route 22057. Beginning at a point on Route 22001 immediately east of the borough line of Millersburg Borough; thence in a southerly direction through Upper Paxton Township to the Millersburg Borough-Upper Paxton Township line, in Dauphin County, a distance of about 0.13 of a mile.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
