Amending Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), entitled "An act codifying and compiling a part of the law of the Commonwealth," changing the penalty for scattering rubbish and returning the fines to the municipality or township.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Section 6501 of Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the "Consolidated Pennsylvania Statutes," added December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended to read: § 6501. Scattering rubbish.
- (a) Offense defined.—A person is guilty of [a summary] an offense if he:
 - (1) throws any waste paper, sweepings, ashes, household waste, glass, metal, refuse or rubbish, or any dangerous or detrimental substance into or upon any road, street, highway, or alley, or upon the land of another or into or upon any stream or navigable river; or
 - (2) interferes with, scatters, or disturbs the contents of any receptacle containing ashes, garbage, household waste, or rubbish.
- (b) Penalty.—A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$300 or to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.
- (c) Disposition of fines.—The fines collected for violations of this section shall be paid into the treasury of the municipality or township in which the offenses occurred for general municipal or township purposes.
