Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing taxation for the purpose of appropriating funds to support ambulance and rescue squads.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection A of section 905, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 905. Township and Special Tax Levies.—A. The board of township supervisors may, by resolution, levy taxes upon all real property and upon all occupations, or upon real property alone, within the township made taxable for township purposes, as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes, for the purposes and at the rates hereinafter specified. All taxes shall be collected in cash.

8. An annual tax, not exceeding one-half mill, for the purpose of supporting ambulance and rescue squads serving the township.
