Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," specifically authorizing community development programs.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1202, act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is amended by adding a clause to read: Section 1202. Specific Powers.—The powers of the borough shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the failure to conform thereto:

(75) To undertake community development programs, including but not limited to urban renewal, public housing, model cities programs and neighborhood development projects.
