Amending the act of May 11, 1973 (P.L.27, No.13), entitled "An act providing for grants to individual non-farm owners of homes or personal property damaged or destroyed by certain floods; establishing the amount of the grants and making an appropriation," increasing the amount which may be allocated by the Governor and establishing a time for payment of grants.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 5, act of May 11, 1973 (P.L.27, No.13), entitled "An act providing for grants to individual non-farm owners of homes or personal property damaged or destroyed by certain floods; establishing the amount of the grants and making an appropriation," is amended to read:

Section 5. A sum not to exceed [forty million dollars (\$40,000,000)] fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) may be allocated by the Governor for the purpose of administering and implementing this act from funds made available under the Emergency Disaster Relief Act of July 7, 1972 (P.L.1889, No.18-A).

Except for grants in the appeal process, grants shall be paid within sixty days after the effective date of this amendatory act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
