## AN ACT

HB 618

Amending the act of November 10, 1965 (P.L.835, No.351), entitled "An act providing pensions for surviving spouses of police officers in cities of the second class A under certain terms and conditions, and providing for contributions by members of the police pension or retirement fund and appropriations by the city for that purpose," providing for increases in the pension of a surviving spouse.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2, act of November 10, 1965 (P.L.835, No.351), entitled "An act providing pensions for surviving spouses of police officers in cities of the second class A under certain terms and conditions, and providing for contributions by members of the police pension or retirement fund and appropriations by the city for that purpose," is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 2. \*\*\*

(e) Each surviving spouse at the time active members of the police force receive an increase in compensation, may receive an increase in their pension in an amount equal to twenty-five per centum of the increase granted to active members of the police force of the same rank as the deceased spouse when he retired from active service.
