## AN ACT

## HB 189

Amending the act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1974 to June 30, 1975, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974; and providing for subpoena powers for legislative appropriation committees," providing for increases in certain appropriations made to the Department of Environmental Resources, the Department of Health, the Department of Justice and the Department of Public Welfare, for an appropriation to the Department of Labor and Industry, adding an appropriation for employees of the Chief Clerk of the Senate, making deficiency appropriations for incidental expenses and legislative printing and expenses of the House of Representatives, for the House Special Leadership Account (R), for the House Special Leadership Account (D), for the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee and providing for the purchase of National Flags.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2, act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1974," is amended by adding appropriations to the Department of Labor and Industry and to the Chief Clerk of the Senate, and by increasing certain appropriations to the Department of Environmental Resources, the Department of Health, the Department of Justice, the Department of Public Welfare, incidental expenses and legislative printing and expenses of the House of Representatives and the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee, and by amending the purchase of flags by the General Assembly; the appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare, the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee, and the appropriation for the purchase of flags, amended and the House Special Leadership Accounts added December 13, 1974 (No.75-A), are amended to read:

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment; land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974.

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To the Department of Environmental Resources

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives for reimbursement of legislative expenses incurred in attending a conference for new members.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$5,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives for reimbursement of costs and expenses of members and officers of the General Assembly attending the conference for new members held in December 1974.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

A SUPPLEMENT

SB 56

To the act of July 12, 1973 (P.L.487, No.11-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1974, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1973," providing for a deficiency in an appropriation to the Department of Education made by the act for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following sum or as much thereof as may be necessary for a deficiency in an appropriation made to the Department of Education is hereby specifically appropriated as follows:

I. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

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To the Department of Education

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For payment into the Social Security Contribution Fund the Commonwealth's share of Federal Social Security taxes for public school employes . . . . . \$1,453,000

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

SB 235

Making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Education for the operation, maintenance and administration of the State colleges and State-owned university.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Education as a supplemental appropriation for the operation, maintenance and administration of the State colleges and State-owned university. This appropriation is in addition to any other appropriation made to the Department of Education for the same purpose for the fiscal year 1974-75.

Section 2. In addition to the above amount, all income and all moneys not subject to refund collected at the several State colleges and Indiana University or received from the Federal Government or from any other source and paid into the General Fund of the State Treasury under existing laws are hereby appropriated out of the General Fund to the several State colleges and Indiana University for the same purpose, each college and university to receive from such appropriation the exact amount which was collected at said college or university or received from the Federal Government or from any other source during the said fiscal period.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

## AN ACT

## HB 522

Amending the act of June 26, 1974 (No. 21-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1974 to June 30, 1975, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974; and providing for subpoena powers for legislative appropriation committees," further providing for the use of certain appropriations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of section 2 act of June 26, 1974 (No. 21-A), known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1974," as relates to the appropriations to the Department of Environmental Resources for Gypsy Moth Operations and Gypsy Moth Control are amended to read:

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974.

HB 181

Amending the act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1974 to June 30, 1975, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974; and providing for subpoena powers for legislative appropriation committees," providing for a deficiency in the appropriation to the Department of Justice and in the appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of section 2, act of June 26, 1974 (No.21-A), known as "The General Appropriation Act of 1974," as relates to the appropriation to the Department of Justice for the State Correctional Institutions and Community Treatment Centers is amended and an appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare is added to read:

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1974.

A SUPPLEMENT

HB 1334

To the act of June 30, 1975 (No.8-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1975," itemizing appropriations required from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for the proper operations of the several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund moneys.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited as the "Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund Supplement to the General Appropriation Act of 1975."

Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund for the fiscal period July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976 to finance programs in the several hereinafter named agencies:

I. EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

To the Governor

For the Office of the Budget to provide for the cost of publishing reports to the Secretary of the Treasury as required by the State and Local Fiscal Assistance Act of 1972	\$ 10,000
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To the Department of Education

For payment to school districts and intermediate units on account of exceptional children	56,000,000

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II. JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT  
Miscellaneous

For the payment to the counties in reimbursement of the direct costs incurred by such counties in the administration and operation of all courts established pursuant to Article V, section 1 of The Pennsylvania Constitution. Costs incurred by the counties in the administration and operation of all courts means costs as reported to the Department of Community Affairs in the county's annual financial report forms under the heading (A) "Judicial," but confined to the subheading: (160) Courts, excluding capital outlay. If a city coterminous with a county does not report on the Department of Community Affairs' form, its figures from the same subheading, set forth in the department forms, shall be used: Provided, That such payments shall be made to the County Treasurer and in cities of the first class coterminous with counties of the first class to the City Treasurer: And, provided further, That in the event the amount herein appropriated is not sufficient to reimburse all such costs, payments shall be made to the counties in the proportion which the costs of each county bears to the total costs of all counties during the most recently completed fiscal year: And provided further, That in making allocations and payments hereunder, the Court Administrator of Pennsylvania shall exclude all costs which are not properly reportable under the heading hereinabove specified ..... 10,000,000

Section 3. All Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund moneys expended by the several State agencies named herein, or by any political subdivision, organization or other agency receiving such moneys from the State agencies named herein shall be spent only in accordance with rules and regulations regarding the expenditure of funds made available under Pub.L. 92-512 entitled State and Local Fiscal Assistance Act of 1972.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
