Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," granting commissioners the power to further amend the county budget under certain circumstances.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 1782.3. Amending Budget, Levy and Tax Rate; Revising Tax Duplicates; Filing.—(a) At any time prior to the time tax duplicates are sent by the county in any year, the commissioners of any county may amend the budget and the levy and tax rate and revise the tax duplicate to conform with its amended budget when such county shall receive unanticipated revenues which may be expended during such county's fiscal year where such unanticipated revenues may enable the commissioners of such county to reduce the levy and tax rate to conform with its amended budget.

(b) Within fifteen days after any amendment to the budget and levy and tax rate, the commissioners shall file a copy thereof in the office of the Department of Community Affairs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
