## AN ACT

HB 1570

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," further providing for an emergency exclusion from the tax for education.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 204, act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the "Tax Reform Code of 1971," is amended by adding a clause to read: Section 204. Exclusions from Tax.—The tax imposed by section 202

shall not be imposed upon

\* \* \*

(37) The sale at retail of buses to be used under contract with school districts that are replacements for buses destroyed or lost in the flood of 1977 for a period ending December 31, 1977 in the counties of Armstrong, Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Jefferson, Somerset and Westmoreland, or the use of such buses.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
