## AN ACT

SB 842

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the use of psychological-stress evaluators, audio-stress monitors and similar devices without consent.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended by adding a section to read:

**§ 7507. *Breach of privacy by using a psychological-stress evaluator, an audio-stress monitor or a similar device without consent.***

***A person commits a misdemeanor of the second degree if he uses a psychological-stress evaluator, an audio-stress monitor or a similar device which measures voice waves or tonal inflections to judge the truth or falsity of oral statements without the consent of the person whose statement is being tested.***

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
