## AN ACT

HB 1627

Repealing certain obsolete laws relating to animals.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following acts are repealed:

Act of May 10, 1729 (1 Sm.L.176, Ch.303), entitled "A supplement to the act, entitled 'An Act to prevent swine running at large.'"

Act of March 4, 1763 (1 Sm.L.257, Ch.490), entitled "An act concerning cattle, horses and sheep, trespassing within this province."

Act of April 7, 1807 (P.L.162, No.98), entitled "An act for the protection of Livery Stable keepers, and Inn keepers within this Commonwealth."

Act of March 15, 1821 (P.L.90, No.60), entitled "An act to encourage the apprehension of persons who shall have committed the crime of horse stealing."

Act of March 5, 1858 (P.L.78, No.101), entitled "A further supplement to an act, passed thirteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seven, relating to Strays."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
