CHAPTER VI.

*An ACT to erect a new election district in
the county of Somerset.*

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the township of Southampton, in the county of Somerset, shall be an election district; and the electors thereof, shall hold their general elections, at the house now occupied by Andrew Emrick, in said township of Southampton.
