

## CHAPTER XXV.

*An ACT altering the place of holding the elections in Air township, in the county of Bedford.*

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the fifth district, in the county of Bedford, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Jacob Four, in M<sup>c</sup>Connellsburgh; any former law to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.
