

CHAPTER XXXVIII.

An ACT to erect Deer township, in the county of Allegheny, into a separate election district.

Deer township in Allegheny county, erected into an election district.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, Deer township, in Allegheny county, shall be a separate election district, and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Thomas M'Connell, in said township.
