Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly

sembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the second election district, composed of Washington and that part of Franklin township, that lies north of the new Frankstown road in the county of Westmoreland, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by John King, in Washington township aforesaid; any law or laws to the contrary notwithstanding.
