CHAPTER LV.

An ACT to erect Allegheny township, in the county of Armstrong, into an election district.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the electors residing within the township of Allegheny, in Armstrong county, shall hold their elections at the house of George Painter, miller, near the mouth of Cherry-run, in said township.
