

CHAPTER LXXVII.

An ACT to annex the township of Dunbar, in Fayette county, to the fourth election district.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the township of Dunbar, in the county of Fayette, shall be annexed to the fourth district; and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the school-house in Connellsville.

The township of Dunbar in Fayette county annexed to the fourth election district.
