CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

*An ACT for the more certain Administration
of Justice.*

WHEREAS, from sickness and other causes, the holding of the courts of justice of this commonwealth, at the regular terms, have been and may hereafter be prevented: Therefore,

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That*

no process, pleas, suits, actions or proceedings which have at any time been, now are, or hereafter shall be commenced, sued, brought, or depending

within this state, shall be discontinued or abate on account of the non-attendance of the justices or judges thereof.

depending before the supreme court, or any other court of this commonwealth, shall be discontinued or put without day, or so considered, by reason of the non-attendance of the justices or judges of the said courts, but shall stand good and effectual in law, to all intents and purposes, notwithstanding the non-attendance of any of the said justices or judges.

CHAPTER LXXXIX.

An ACT for the regulation of the Militia of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That each and every free, able-bodied, white male citizen, of this or any other of the United States, and every other free, able-bodied white male person who has been resident in this commonwealth for six months previous to the time of his enrolment, who is or shall be of the age of eighteen years, and under the age of forty-five years, except as
