

CHAPTER CXXIV.

An ACT to erect a certain election district in the county of Wayne.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the township of Buckingham, Demascus and that part of Lackawaxen township, lying north of Lackawaxen creek, and east of the Barrens in said township, are hereby erected into a separate election district, to be called Saint Tammany district, and the electors thereof, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Reuben Skinner, in said county.
