An ACT to erect the townships of Pennsbury, Kennett, East-Marlborough and Newlin, in the county of Chester, into a separate election district.

**P**E it enacted by the Senate and Section 1. House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the Kennet, East-passing of this act, the townships of Pennsbury, Marlborough .
