day thereof, and if upon the return of the service of the summons as aforesaid, the owner or owners as aforesaid, or other persons actually possessing the land shall not appear and answer to the suit, judgement shall be rendered for the amount of the fees due thereon as of default, and he shall thereupon proceed to sell at public sale, all or any part or parts of the said land, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the said office fees thereon due, together with all the expences of advertising and costs of prosecution.
