

CHAPTER CLX.

A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled "An act to prevent the exportation of bad or unmerchantable staves, heading, boards and timber."

Section 1. **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That no staves shall be deemed as merchantable and fit for exportation, which are not three inches wide, and otherwise conformable to the act to which this is a supplement. What staves shall be deemed merchantable.
