

CHAPTER XVI.

An ACT to erect Buffaloe Township, in the County of Cumberland, into a separate Election-District.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the township of Buffaloe, in Cumberland county, shall be a separate election-district, and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by William Thomson, in Buffaloe township aforesaid; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
