

CHAPTER LIII.

An ACT requiring the Trustees of Mercer County to surrender their Trust to the Commissioners of said County.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the autho-

riety of the same, That the authority vested in the trustees of Mercer county, by an act passed March the twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and three, shall, from and after the first day of June next, cease and determine, and the said trustees shall, on or before the said day, deliver over and surrender to the commissioners of said county, for the time being, all monies, bonds, notes, books, documents, vouchers and papers which have come to their hands as trustees aforesaid, and are in any wise belonging or appertaining to their office and trust under and in pursuance of the act aforesaid, and all the duties of the said trustees, which remained to be performed, shall therefrom be vested in and performed by the commissioners of Mercer county aforesaid.
