CHAPTER LXVIII.

An ACT granting Arrearages of State-Taxes yet due from York County to the Directors of the Poor.

WHEREAS application hath been made to the Legislature, by petition, praying, that the arrearages of State-taxes yet due from the county of York may be granted to the directors of the poor of said county, to assist in defraying the expence of erecting a house for the employment and support of the poor; and as it appears that there is but a small balance now due from said county: Therefore, in order to aid so laudable an undertaking,

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the arrearages of State-taxes now due from the county

CHAPTER LXIX.

An ACT declaring Part of Wyconisco Creek, in the County of Dauphin, a public Highway.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Wyconisco creek, in the county of Dauphin, from the mouth thereof up to Isaac Ferree's mill-dam, be, and the same is hereby declared a public highway, for the passage of rafts, boats and other vessels, and it shall be lawful for the inhabitants, and others desirous of using the navigation of said creek, to remove all natural and artificial obstructions which may be in the same, excepting dams for mills or other water-works, and also to erect
