CHAPTER CXL.

An ACT for extending an act, entitled, "An act regulating and continuing the distribution of Donation Lands."

The former act continued. Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled, "An act regulating and continuing the distribution of donation lands," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and five, be, and the same is hereby extended, and all matters

matters and things therein contained, (the limitation clause only excepted) shall be and continue in force until the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seven.

CHAPTER CXLI.

An ACT to organize the Provisional County of Indiana.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the first Monday in November next, the inhabitants of Indiana county, shall enjoy all and singular the jurisdiction, powers, rights, liberties and privileges, within the same, which the inhabitants of other counties in this State do enjoy by the constitution and laws of this commonwealth.
