CHAPTER CLVI.

*A SUPPLEMENT to the act, entitled, "An act to enable the Governor, to incorporate a Company, for making an artificial road by the best and nearest route from the borough of Sunbury, in the county of Northumberland, to the borough of Reading, in the county of Berks.*

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the president, managers and company, of the Centre Turnpike Road, leading from Reading to Sunbury, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make and construct so much of said road, as is comprised within the following limits, *viz.* Beginning in the old Sunbury road, near Titsworth's tavern, about thirteen miles from Sunbury, and extend-

extending through the Bear Gap, and from thence by the shortest and best route, about thirty miles towards Reading, under the same regulations and restrictions, and with the same powers, privileges, franchises and emoluments, as is prescribed by and under the act, to which this is a supplement.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That whenever three hundred and fifty or more shares shall be subscribed, it shall and may be lawful for the Governor by letters patent, to create and erect the subscribers into one body politic and corporate, in the manner prescribed by the act aforesaid.

When the Governor may erect the subscribers into a body politic.

Sec. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if the said company shall commence and complete the said road, as prescribed by the first section of this act in the time limited by the act, to which this a supplement, then, and in that case, the said company shall not incur a forfeiture thereof, so far as respects the said road within the limits aforesaid.

Time allowed to complete the part of the road mentioned in the first section.

Sec. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That John Dorsey, Samuel Meeker, Thomas Fitzimmons, and Peter Robison, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, in addition to those already appointed, under the act aforesaid.
