CHAPTER CXCH.

An ACT making appropriations for improving the Road leading from near the Bald Eagle's Nest, in Centre County, to the river Allegheny, in Venango County, and a Road in Greene County.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the State treasurer, for the sum of five hundred dollars, to be paid to the commissioners of Centre Five hundred and three hundred dollars granted to the commissioners of Centre and Venango coun- county, Venango coun-

ties, respectively, for improving certain parts of the road leading from Bald Eagle's Nest, in Centre county, to the house of Elias Holman, on the Allegheny river.

county, out of any unappropriated monies in the treasury of this commonwealth, to be by them applied in improving so much of the road leading from the Bald Eagle's Nest, in Centre county to the Allegheny river, in Venango county, as lies between David Euan's mill, in Centre county aforesaid, and Joseph Barnett's mill, on Sandy Lick creek, and a like warrant for the further sum of three hundred dollars, of such monies to be paid to the commissioners of Venango county, to be applied by them in improving so much of said road as lies between the aforesaid Barnett's mill and the dwelling of Elias Holman, on the Allegheny river."

The aforesaid commissioners authorised to contract for the improvement of said road, &c.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That it shall and may be lawful for the commissioners of Centre county, and for the commissioners of Venango county, or a majority of them, respectively, to contract with any person or persons for improving said road or any part or parts thereof, within the limits assigned to them, respectively, and to take such surety or sureties for the faithful performance of such contract or contracts, as they or a majority of them, respectively, may deem necessary.

Two hundred dollars granted to the commissioners of Greene county for improving a certain road, &c.

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to draw his warrant on the State treasurer, for the sum of two hundred dollars, to be paid to the commissioners of Greene county, out of any monies in the treasury of this commonwealth, to be applied by them in improving a road leading from David Gray's, in the county of Greene, to the western boundary of the State, towards the flats of Grave creek; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them,

them, may contract with any person or persons for improving said road, and take such surety or sureties for the faithful performance of such contract or contracts as they may deem necessary.

Sec. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the commissioners of Centre, the commissioners of Venango, and the commissioners of Greene counties, to render an account of the expenditure of the monies aforesaid, to the auditors for settling the accounts of the commissioners and treasurers of their respective counties, who are hereby authorized to adjust and settle the same, and allow to each of the said commissioners one dollar and thirty-three cents, for every day they shall be necessarily employed in performing the duties required of them by this act, to be paid out of the treasury of their respective counties.
